






















Design thinking principles in SECAP development

What is the problem? **EMPATHISE** Municipality has looked at different other SECAPs and wishes to have their own SECAP with better and more targeted measures.



IDEATE)

How do we solve it?

Municipality and stakeholders come up with 10 different ways how to identify better and more targeted measures in their SECAP.

Municipality researches

and defines what do they mean with better and more target measures.





Does it work?

Once tested, the group evaluates which of the tested solutions has given better results and selects for further application.



How do we create it?

The group decides which of the 10 solutions they will try and test. They test, e.g., three ideas proposed by the participants of the group.



Climate Budget mainstreaming – elaboration of a methodology to facilitate the issue





Main challenges

- Raising Interest: SECAPs overlap with national initiatives in some countries; numerous actions and parallel initiatives for LAs
- Limited availability of personnel within local authorities
- Reaching out is challenging: the overall communication offer is tremendous over all channels (we slip under the radar)
- Adapting to local contexts in each each country





The LIFE programme was instrumental for us:

- It gave us the opportunity to explore in depth new fields and techniques and adapt them to the needs of the LAs (e.g. Climate budget, design thinking, CoM, etc.)
- Best practices and cooperation between project partners based on expertise is a real advantage
- P2P within 11 countries and more is really inspirational
